Firefly Coffehouse Show

Linda Krantz has reserved the Firefly Coffeehouse in Oregon, Wisconsin for a MAG exhibit during July/August 2024. Based on the amount of wall footage and recommendations from the Firefly curator, this show can accommodate either 14 artists utilizing 5 feet of wall space each, or 10 artists utilizing 7 feet of wall space each. Another option is for 2 artists to share a 7 ft. section. The application process will begin in May. All sales are handled between the artist and the buyer. There is no fee and no percentage taken from any sales. Please begin thinking about whether you are interested in participating in this show. It's a great space for exhibiting.

Paoli Art in the Park 2024

Is anyone interested in taking on the role of Chairperson for a MAG booth at Paoli Art in the Park? Application deadline is May 15, and the fair runs August 31st - September 1st. Chairing responsibilities would include running a lottery of interested artists and choosing 4 artists to occupy the MAG tent (you would have an automatic spot for a total of 5 artists), helping to set up the tent, being present for the run of the art fair, selling your art and helping with tent take-down. If you'd like to work with someone, co-chairing is also a possibility, and that person would also have an automatic spot in the tent. The \$300 double booth fee would be evenly split among all 5 participants. If you are interested in chairing/co-chairing, Owen Gwynne can answer any questions you may have.



MAG Bylaws for your review

Please review the attached copy of the proposed changes to the MAG Bylaws. We will be voting on them at the May meeting.

For your convenience, we have included an overview of the changes:

OVERVIEW OF PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE MADISON ART GUILD, INC. BYLAWS

General:

• Clarity was added to the document to include more detail on some operations and add others that we saw in other art organization's bylaws.

Article I:

 Legal name - General language was added to note the legal name of the organization as well as its acronym.

Article II:

 The Statement of Purpose was added to match the purpose stated in other MAG documents as well as the website.

Article III:

Board of Directors was established to include the Chairs of Standing Committees. We felt it was
important to include them in operational discussions because of their impact on committee
work. It also outlines the structure of MAG, roles of the officers, and terms of office.

Article IV:

Committees are described, and several are proposed (Exhibitions, Nominating, Events). This
reflects a desire to move MAG from having individuals shouldering the responsibilities of
various activities, and instead requiring the collective efforts of committees to have more
volunteers involved.



Article V:

 Membership and Dues describes the terms of membership, includes an equal opportunity statement, lists membership classifications, and spells out the benefits of Artist Members (those who have passed jury) and Associate Members (those who choose not to jury, or just want to be members). It also discusses dues and payment deadlines.

Article VI:

Voting Rights clarifies who is allowed to vote and under what circumstances.

Article VII:

Expectations of MAG Members discusses what MAG needs from its members to grow and be
of service.

Article VIII:

 Meetings of the Board of Directors will take place 15-30 minutes prior to General Membership meetings (when needed) to discuss matters of importance to the organization.

Article IX:

 Data Management encourages the use of the Google Drive for storage and sharing of information pertinent to MAG and its operations. For example, documents and procedures related to committees.

Article X:

Quorum clarifies what this means in any given circumstance.

Article XI:

Amendments to Bylaws can be made according to the guidelines set forth in this article.

Article XII:

• Authorized use of the Madison Art Guild, Inc. name clarifies how a member can/can't use the name of the organization.

Article XIII:

 Procedures for Disciplinary Action toward a MAG member further establishes expectations for members and outlines the response the organization will take if/when necessary to maintain our professional integrity.
